Health and safety reminders

All of the following reminders may seem trivial but in all these cases the consequences of not following them could be extremely serious or life threatening.

Arriving at breakfast club, arriving or leaving Nursery and dropping off or collecting from 2C: Please do not walk through the Junior School car park gate. This is very unsafe as this is the entrance to a busy car park that is used throughout the day. Please walk through the pedestrian gate that is next to the car park gate.

Bikes and Scooters: Please can we remind you that children with bikes or scooters should walk with them, not ride them, in the playground. This is for the safety of others in the playground and because our site is next to a busy road.

Packed lunches: Please do not give your child nuts or food items containing nuts, including Nutella type sandwich filling. We have children in school who are highly allergic to nuts.
