In January, Turnfurlong Infant School will be celebrating our 50<sup>th</sup> birthday. #### Applications for Reception and Year 3 school places in September 2024

If your child is in Year 2 you must apply for their Year 3 school place at Junior school. If your child is in Nursery, and they were born between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2019 and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020, you must apply for a Reception place.

You must submit your application to Buckinghamshire Council by Monday 15<sup>th</sup> January 2024.
