


## 4.1 Play assembly risk-benefit log – High risk resources

Date	Audience/Resource	Topic	Agreed management and mitigations
27/2/24	All children and all staff	CINI assembly to introduce new resources and equipment	
Scooters		Popular – will need timer and turn taking in specified area No helmets required but awareness of speed, direction and others	<ul> <li>One way system around the zoned off area (orange barriers)</li> <li>Speed reduction e.g. around cones</li> <li>Removal of individuals who cannot use the scooters safety around others e.g. too fast/ too competitive</li> </ul>
Go Karts and ride on toys		Use on field rather than on playground surface Spatial awareness due to other resources out	<ul> <li>Discussion around fingers near moving wheels</li> <li>Risk awareness of chains and finger traps</li> <li>Spatial awareness around others</li> </ul>
Tree climbing in copse area behind hall		Rota will be redone to support supervision of rear site area behind hall Children to only climb to line marking on tree, no higher.	<ul> <li>Removal of low 'twig' branches to promote safe climbing/ hand holds/ foot holds and avoid facial areas</li> <li>Log stump to provide safe 'step' by trunk for climbing/ dismount</li> <li>Children to only climb on branches as thick as their wrist to support weight</li> <li>May be slippery when wet</li> <li>Regular check by site manager for natural berries/ fungi/ bees/ wasps associated with trees in wild area</li> </ul>





Natural obstacle course – log stumps	Log stumps are uneven and will roll/move Balance and awareness of others around obstacle course	<ul> <li>Children to take care with stumps and planks if balancing from one to the other as may be wobbly/ uneven</li> <li>Not too close to trees or fences where others may be playing</li> <li>May be slippery when wet</li> </ul>

Fire Pit	H&S mitigation – water to hand to extinguish if necessary Storage of fuel away from roundhouse, trees and other combustible sources	leader supporting adding on twigs/ logs. Only adults to use matches (initially)  Not to be used in high winds or heavy rain  Appropriate storage of materials and
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
