The morning will begin with a talk in the hall about how we teach maths at Turnfurlong Infant School, the maths hub project we are involved in and how we are teaching with materials from the National Centre for Excellence in the Teaching of Mathematics to support number fluency and key skills. The session in the hall will be followed by time in the classrooms, where you will be able to work with your child on a range of activities. We will share these with you afterwards so that you can continue to use them with your child at home. The site will be secured once the talk in the hall has begun with no entry after this time.
