		<p>Simple Present Tense</p> <p>Base Form of Verb or Base Form + "S."</p>	<p>Present</p> <p>The current moment in which we live</p>
			<p>Change</p> <p>When objects grow or evolve into a newer version</p>
<p>Physical features are naturally occurring areas of land, such as rivers, forest, hills, mountains.</p>	<p>Human features have been added to the land by people over time, for example, stone walls, buildings, roads.</p>		<p>Maps</p> <p>A map is a drawing of an area that shows features and scale, and can be used for different purposes.</p>

			<p>Chronology</p> <p>Putting events in order</p>
