Dear Parents

It has been another busy week at school. The children in Year 1 and 2 have moved into their new Read Write Inc phonics groups and everyone is getting used to going into new places in school for this. As I've said before, there is quite a lot of change happening with our teaching of reading and phonics so please come to our workshops in school that are running over the next couple of weeks if you are able to.

## **Is my child too ill to come to school?**

Good attendance at school is absolutely critical to children making good progress in their learning. We also know that children will often pick up bugs and infections, particularly when they first start Nursery and Reception.

If your child has a temperature please keep them at home but if they have runny nose or a cough or a bit of a sore throat they should still come to school. We will always call parents to come to school and collect if we think that a child is too ill to be here. Children with diarrhoea or vomiting must stay away from school until they have not been sick or had diarrhoea for at least 2 days (48 hours).

## **Headlice and nits**

Nobody likes to think about this but unfortunately it is something that lots of young children get while they are at school. Please check your child's hair regularly. If you do find headlice or nits you will need to treat your child and all the family, including you!

### **School lunches**

Have the children talked about what they are eating for their school dinner at home? At the end of the Summer holidays new catering equipment was put in the hall kitchen and this means that we are no longer having our meals delivered to school every day. Much more preparation is happening on site now. I think that the quality of the food has really improved because of this so if you have a child in Year 1 and Year 2 who hasn't tried school dinners for a while it might be worth having another try. School dinners are free for all children at our school.

### **OPAL**

Our school is an 'Outdoor Play and Learning' (OPAL) school. This means that the children can play with a wide range of resources in the playground at playtime and lunchtime. Children are also able to play on the field for almost all of the year, go into the nature area and play in the mud kitchen. Having so much fun in all weathers does mean that children can sometimes get quite muddy. We therefore ask all parents to send in the following things to be kept in school

- A named pair of welly boots
- A complete change of warm clothes

Children should bring a waterproof coat to school **every day**. Please would you also ensure that shoes are named, as children are having difficulty in recognising their own shoes when they change out of their wellies. Thank you.
